

Dr. Nygaard, of Luverne, Died Oct. 15

Dr. Gabriel Osmundson Nygaard passed away Tuesday, October 15th, at his home in Luverne. He was born near Stavanger, Norway, May 19th, 1885, and came to this country when sixteen years of age. He attended school at Page and Valley City, and took a medical course at Chicago University, graduating in 1910. He located at Luverne and soon established himself as a conservative and skillful man in his profession.

On January 4, 1909, he was united in marriage to Hulda Olsen Holtan, a daughter of Rev. Holtan. His wife and four children, also his father and mother survive him. He was a victim of that most insidious disease, tuberculosis, from which he has been a sufferer for the past several years.

Funeral services were held Saturday at the home and at the Lund church by Rev. Sigurd Olson and Rev. P. A. Thoreson. Interment was made in the Lund cemetery.

In his contact with friends and patients he radiated hope and success. Everything was sure to work out right. He was the most hopeful man in the sick-room and when he knew the spark of life was very low he cheerily said, "We have fought a hard fight." He will be greatly missed by his friends and associates on account of his many sterling qualities.
