

## Tom O. Sad

Tosten Olson Sad died at his home in Dover township on Thursday, October 24th. He had been of poor health for several years, but the immediate cause of his death was heart trouble.

Tosten Sad came to Wisconsin from Norway 34 years ago. He remained in Wisconsin for four years, coming to Griggs county thirty years ago, and settling on a claim in Dover township, where he has since resided.

Deceased is survived by his wife and five children; two boys, Ole and Oscar; and three girls, Clara, Annie and Esther, all staying at home. One daughter, Mrs. Susie Sebby, died last summer.

The funeral was held Monday afternoon from the house, and interment was made in Eidfjord cemetery, Rev. P. A. Thoreson officiating.

With the death of Tosten Sad another old pioneer passes. He suffered the usual trials and hardships of the early settlers, and did his share to build up the community and make life easier for those who come after. He has gone to his final reward, and those who remain can only say: "Rest in Peace."
