

About one A. M. last Wednesday morning fire was discovered in the barn belonging to Ole Sad of Dover township. Within the barn were nineteen head of horses, his harnesses, hay and two hogs. Nothing was saved, and the hired man, who was asleep in the barn at the time, barely escaped with his life. The cause of the fire is unknown. The loss is partly covered by insurance. Two of the horses belonged to Gust Ekstrand, including the Percheron stallion Binford. William Angus had written \$500 insurance upon this stallion, which amount was promptly paid.
