

Hans Oppegard

Hans Oppegard was born at Loiten, Norway Dec 16, 1852. He was second of 7 boys and 3 girls of his father's family. He came to Minneapolis in 1878, then Barnes Co., in 1879. His homestead and tree claims adjoined the present town of Dazey. 5 brothers and 2 sisters also came to America.

Mr. Oppegard was appointed Co. Commissioner in 1885, and after ward elected for 2 terms, and elected sheriff in 1902 + in 1904.
