

EARLY GRIGGS COUNTY HISTORY NOTES

In 1904, there were creameries operating at Hennaford and Cooperstown.

----- Cooperstown Courier--June 18, 1904

Rev. Ole Knutson Quamme, a pioneer pastor of Griggs county and the first Norwegian pastor in Griggs, Bonness Twp. was born in ~~Lerdal~~ ^{Lardal}, Norway. Nov. 3, 1858; came to Minnesota in 1864; married Ingrid Olson in 1874; studied for the ministry at Augsburg college, Minneapolis; became a minister in 1886 at which time he accepted a call in the Cooperstown vicinity. On June 18, 1904 while on a vacation in Minn. where he owned a farm, suffered an accident while unhitching horses. The accident proved fatal. Rev. Quamme left a wife and 4 children. Funeral services were held at ~~Cooperstown~~ ^{Crookston, Minn.}
