

Thomas Stee, Dazey, N.D.

Thomas Stee is a farmer, born at Rock Prairie Wisconsin, on Mar 4, 1859. His father was Ole Knudsen Stee and his mother, Ragnhild Quissil, was from Vestre Slide. She came to America about 1850. Ole was one of the pioneers of Barnes Co. Thomas and his brother Knut came with their father to Barnes County near Dazey in 1880. He died in 1883. His mother and his brother Knut are also dead. They were among the earliest settlers.
