

13 Years Without Accident, 149 Cooperstown Bus Driver Quits

Cooperstown, N. D.—Fred Oakley of Cooperstown has retired as a driver for the Dakota Bus Line with a record of 13 years without an accident. Oakley started work-

ing as a bus driver at Lisbon, N. D., where he spent three years before coming to Cooperstown.

The only interruption in his service was 22 months spent in the navy.
