

Lt. Opsvig Of Minot Presumed To Be Dead

Minot, N. D.—Mr. and Mrs. Claus Opsvig of Minot have been notified that their son, Lt. John Thomas Opsvig, 22, reported missing in action over China May 6, 1944, is presumed to be dead. Lt. Opsvig was pilot of a P-38 fighter plane which left from southwest China on a bomber escort mission to Hankow, China.

The Opsvigs received a letter from an air staff officer which said that the planes encountered enemy aircraft in the area southwest of Hankow and in the ensuing engagement Lt. Opsvig's plane disappeared.
