

Mrs. Olson Taken By Death Friday

Rites Held Monday at West
Prairie Church; Born

Mrs. Oscar L. Olson, 43, died at her farm home, five miles northwest of Jessie, Friday of last week as a result of a stroke. She first suffered a stroke last summer and never fully recovered.
