Ole Oust, 78, Dies At Home Tuesday

Aged Cooperstown Citizen
Passes Here Following
Recent Stroke.

Ole Oust, 78, aged Cooperstown citizen, passed away at his home here on Tuesday afternoon of this week, following a stroke suffered a couple of days previously. Mr. Oust had been in ailing health for some time suffering with the infirmities of old age which had left him nearly blind.

He was born in Trondhjem, Norway, on January 27, 1858, and at the time of his death was 77 years, 9 months and 25 days old. He came to this country more than fifty-two years ago. From pioneer days he lived on a farm east of Cooperstown, but about two years ago moved to this city with his wife to make their home, retiring from active farm work. He is survived by his wife, a brother in Merseus, California, a brother in Winnipeg, Manitoba, and a sister in Trondhjem, Norway.

Funeral services will be held from the Ness church on Friday (tomorrow) at 2 o'clock in the afternoon. Short services will be held from the home at 1 o'clock. Burial will be in the Ness cemetery.
