

# Mrs. Iver Olson, At Cooperstown, De

Cooperstown, N. D. — Funeral services for Mrs. Iver (M) Olson, 78, who died at a hospital here Monday were held Wednesday at the S. J. Quam funeral home in Cooperstown with Rev. Mr. Laatz officiating.

Mrs. Olson was born in Polk county, Wis., Feb. 9, 1873, and was the first white child born in that community. In 1893, she married Iver Olson at Grantsburg, Wis. Her husband died in 1909. For the past 15 years, she had been living with her brother and sister-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. W. H. Phelps, of Binford, N. D.

She is survived by two sons, Ernest, of Grantsburg, Wis., and William, of Oakland, Calif., two sisters, Mrs. Oscar Carlson, of Marine on St. Croix, Minn., and Mrs. George Cole, of Niles, Mich., two brothers, Frank Phelps, of Danbury, Wis., and William Phelps, of Binford, seven grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.
