He came to North Dakota in March 1902, leaving his former home to get rich as the speculation was big in North Dakota. He settled in Sec. 1, Coopers township, the house was frame and machinery was, the mower, binder, drill, plow which was operated by horses. His early neighbors were Gossells & Corchert and the nearest school was the Triggard school. Church services were held at the Arnett school house. He used river wood & coal for fuel. In Oct. 1879 he married Sophia Buezing at Bremer Co. Iowa. He now lives at Coopers township, N. D.
