It seems that there is considerable difficulty experienced at this season of the year in teams passing each other on the country roads. Usually the team with the load has the right of way and sometimes the drivers of light vehicles have considerable trouble in passing, as the man with the load will not budge an inch and force the light load into anywhere from three to six feet of snow in order to get by. Naturally there is some strong language used on these occasions. "Turn to the right" is a pretty good rule and a little fairness on both sides ought to remedy the matter.
