was one of the first settlers in Griggs county coming here in 1881. His wife died on the Nelson homestead just north of town in '88. Five children are now living Nels E. Nelson, Peter E. Nelson, Mrs. Jacob Hanson, Ben E. Nelson and Mrs. Ole Havig. The remains were brought over to Cooperstown Tuesday and were interred in the cemetery at this place Tuesday afternoon, the funeral ceremonies being conducted by Rev. E. T. Silness.
