

Nels M. Rood died at the home of his brother, Martin Rood, in this city about six o'clock Saturday morning. The deceased had a hemorrhage of the lungs several weeks ago and has been in a bad condition ever since, although hopes were entertained that he might possibly recover. Friday night, however, he was taken with an attack of pleurisy which filled up his lungs and he passed quietly away as stated. Nels came over from Norway about two years ago, and would have been 19 years old the 14th of September. He told Martin that he would die before morning on Friday night and requested to see his spiritual adviser, Rev. Voldal. They sang a hymn together and the young man said that all was well with him and passed away expressing the belief that all was well with his soul. The funeral service was held in the Lutheran church Sunday afternoon Rev. J. M. Jensen, the pastor, officiating. The remains were interred in the cemetery.
