Martin Christopherson, who has been conducting a shoe repair shop in Binford, was found dead in his place of business last Friday afternoon. Dr. Truscott, who held an autopsy over the dead body, declares that death had occurred at about 11 o'clock Thursday evening, and pronounced it due to heart failure. Mr. Christopherson had not been feeling well for the past two weeks, according to statements of those who had visited his place of business. Judging from the position of the body, it is apparent that he had arisen from his bed to fix the fire, as he had on a pair of gloves and a small shovel was grasped in his right hand. He fell face downward with his head near the front of the stove. The body was prepared for burial and relatives from Romness township were here Sunday to take the remains there. Intermeat was made in the Ottawa cemetery. Mr. Christopherson was born in Wisconsin 55 years ago. Further particulafs are lacking at this time.
