R L Jones, of Hannaford, has been named county campaign directer or the Interchurch World Movement of Griggs county.

The appointment is made by Wesley McDowell, state campaign director with offices in Fargo, Mr. Jones will have charge in a

general way, of each of the co-openating denominational drives for the funds in Griggs county, and in this capacity will combine nearly a dozen drives which would ordinarily bi made separately.

In view of the attention which this united campaign is expected to attract, there is to be made of persons who are friendly to the church or who may not have been reached by the denominational canvasses in the county. The minimum amounts to be raised in this county from the people who are not regular contributors to the support of the church is \$2,000.

"It has been pointed out," Mr. Jones says, "that the co-operation of the churches will make possible tinancial ingathering of \$336,000 which will make possible unheard of things in the service of the Christian church to all humanity. "When we realize how little this scally amounts to as a donation of

each church member, or from those persons who are friendly with the whurch, a success of the movement is assured."
