

MRS. JULIA ALFSTAD DEAD

Mrs. Julia Thune Alfstad was born in Valdres, Norway, on March 18th, 1851. On March 11, 1875, she was united in marriage to Knud Alfstad, and to which union was born nine children, two of whom are deceased. Mr. and Mrs. Alfstad came to America in 1877 and settled in Goodhue county, Minnesota, where they lived until the spring of 1883, when they moved to this state and made their home on a farm near McHenry.

The children who mourn the loss of a kind loving mother are Knud Alfstad, of Wichita, Kansas, Ole, of Minot, John, of Juanita, Iver, of Sandpoint, Idaho, Mrs. Emma Knutson, of Sheyenne, and Mrs. Randina Canton, of Watson, Minnesota. One brother, John Thune, and one sister, Mrs. T. H. Dahl, also survive her.

Mrs. Alfstad has been a sufferer from cancer of the stomach for a long time and last fall on October 6 was taken to the hospital at Jamestown for treatment. She passed away on Saturday last, February 11th.

The remains were shipped to McHenry where the funeral is held today from the Lutheran church, the services being conducted by Rev. L. M. Halling, of Binford. The body will be laid to rest by the side of her husband, who passed away some years ago.
