

## MRS. JOHN STORKSON

DIED WEDNESDAY

Mrs. John Storkson passed away at her home last Wednesday morning at 7:00 o'clock, February 28, following an illness of several weeks duration. She contracted bronchial trouble last fall from which she never fully recovered, and, which developed into consumption, which caused her death.

Lizzie Larson is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Ole Larson, of near McHenry, and was born in Dyrdal, Sogn, Norway, on July 3, 1892. She came with her parents to America in 1902, and settled on a farm near McHenry.

On January 2, 1912, she was united in marriage to Mr. John Storkson, to which union were born two children, Ingeborg, aged eight, and Julian, aged four, who are left to mourn the loss of a kind and loving mother.

The funeral was held Saturday afternoon, the services being conducted by Rev. Hougen, of McHenry. Interment was made in the Zion church cemetery.
