

# AMERICAN LEGION POST SPONSORING A SKATING RINK

PERMISSION WILL BE OBTAINED  
FROM RAILWAY COMPANY TO  
USE RIGHT-OF-WAY AND WA-  
TER FROM TANK

A skating rink for Binford is practically an assured fact.

The local post of the American Legion is back of the movement, and has taken the matter up with the Northern Pacific officials. Yesterday, a representative of the railroad company was in Binford to confer with the post members, and after going into the proposition thoroughly, he gave the boys much encouragement, and stated that upon his recommendation he believed the company would act favorably. As soon as the company's permission is granted, work of clearing the ground and banking the sides will commence. The rink is to be located on the right-of-way, extending from main street and a block east, and about 75 feet wide.

Scoutmaster Bixby will lend his aid, and has stated that his boys will assist in keeping the ice clean.

Water will be obtained from the railroad company's tank.
