The work of the Binford public schools is reported to be progressing in a very harmonious and satisfactory manner, which hould be a matter of gratifiction to all our citlizens. The public school teacher is entitled to the hearty co-operation of parents as well as the general public. We are too often prone to . neglect such encouragement and aid as would tend to lighten the burden - of these teachers, whose calling and - mission are of the highest import-. ance to civilization and the future citizenship of the land in respect to its virtue and worth. Let us try more often to extend a sympathetic as well as helpful hand
