ABRAHAM STORE AT COURTENAY BURNED Courtenay was visited by a disastrous fire early Christmas morning which destroyed about one-third of the east side of Main street. The old Clark building which was formerly the Courtenay Hotel, but was now occupied by Abraham's General store, was completely destroyed, as was most of Larson's hardware store. A strong wind from the south was blowing and it was only by hard fighting that the rest of the business places were saved.
