## Of The Board of County Commissions.

Sherbrooke, N. Dak. Nov. 17, 1905.  
The Board of County Commissioners convened at 9 o'clock a. m. pursuant to call of County Auditor. All members present.

Bills as follows were on motion allowed:

On motion adjournment was taken until 1:30 p. m. same day.

On motion duly seconded and carried, the Sheriff was instructed to proceed with the collection of the 1904 personal property taxes, assessed in the name of Andrew Erickson, now known as Andrew E. Urness, by levying on threshing Engine and Separator.
