Many old time pioneers will be sorry to learn of the untimely death of Chauncey Russ a former resident of Steele county which occured at Chicago a few days ago. While attempting to carry out furniture from a burning building the wall fell in and Mr. Russ was buried beneath the falling timbers. He was removed alive but never recovered consciousness and died four hours later. Mr. Russ was a half brother of the late T. J. Foster, of LaPort, Ind., and who up to recently owned the big Fosterfarm four miles north of this city.
