

Rural Route No. 3

The initiative trip over Rural Route No. 3 is being made today. Gus McLaughlin has the contract and is in charge. The route covers a distance of thirty-two miles and will afford daily mail service to something like two hundred families. The route is in a northeastly direction, and goes within two miles of Sherbrooke and taps one of the best settled sections of the county. The territory tributary to Hope is now practically all reached by the rural routes. This together with the excellent phone service the south half of Steele county certainly has no kick coming and it can no longer be said that we are living on the frontier, with all these modern improvements at hand. Again we say, let the good work go on and in the mean time watch Hope and the south half of Steele county grow and prosper.
