The Board of Equalization resumed work and took up the equalization of assessments on shares bank stock. On motion it was ordered that for the purpose of equalization the assessed valuations of bank stock in the city of Cooperstown be reduced 30 per cent.

This completed the equalization of the assessments and the Board proceeded to a conisderation of the tax levies.
