#### Devils Lake Fire.

Telegraphic advices from Devils Lake state that a fire broke out in Graham's jewelry store on Fourth street in that city early on Monday morning, and spread rapidly each way, burning one and one-half blocks of the business least \$100,000, on which there is \$60,000 dollars insurance.
