VANDERBILT'S LOSSES

Many Millions Said to Have Been Dropped in Speculation.

There is no doubt that William H. is a much poorer man than he was two years ago. In fact his losses on account of unfortunate speculations, and especially of those of his sons, are estimated at from \$30,000,000 to \$50,000,000. Since the old Commodore died, Cornclius and William K. Vanderbilt have speculated heavily with disastrous results, and their father, William H., has been obliged to shoulder their losses. It is now a matter of current report that the elder Vanderbilt has been hardly pinched for ready cash, and that his immense fortune has rapidly been diminishing. The Wall-street brokers are very reticent when questioned about the matter and decline to be quoted, but they admit the rumors of Vanderbilt's losses are well founded. When the old commodore died he left Cornelius \$5,000,000 and William K. \$2,000,000. These amounts, it is said, were first invested in United States bonds, which yielded Cornelius an income of \$200,000 and William K. about \$80,000 a year. These incomes, however, were not sufficient to keep their families in the style in which they had been accustomed to live, and the two brothers, instead of living within their income, went into stock specula-tions and lost. Their losses were very heavy, and their father was called upon to make them good The various brokers of Cornelius on Wall street decline to talk about his losses, and say that they have no right to reveal the business of their customers. They will not deny that he has lost, but say that he is abundantly able to pay, inasmuch as he has his father's income to back

'For two or three years he has been loaded with stocks," said a well informed broker yesterday. "He purchased them at high prices, and since there has been a very heavy falling off. His brother went into speculation about the same time, but, as his fortune was not as large as that of Cornelius, he went under first. At the time they went into their Fifth-avenue palace their mania for speculation first showed itself.

"Some time ago William K. appealed to his father for aid, and, although the latter has denied that he has given his son any financial assistance, there is no doubt that he assumed all his son's holdings of stock at a price to relieve him of loss. William H.'s entry into the stock market and his alliance with Jay Gould dated from that time. He did this in order to unload the securities that had come into his possession in the manner stated.

"Cornelius was loaded with a line of general stocks, which had for a long time been depreciating, and he had a heavy lot of Lake Erie and Western which had depreciated in value since the highest price in 1881 nearly \$7,000,-000. Cornelius, I am told, had from 30,000 to 35,000 shares of this stock. What his losses are it is impossible to tell, but they were shouldered by his father, who is a heavy loser. He went to Europe in May last and was not here to take care of his holdings at the time of the panic and the great depressions in prices. Cornelius has fled to Europe now. He was always considered a very conservative and pious man, as he was vestryman in St. Bartholomew's Church, where he passed around the plate."

The financial trouble of the Vanderbilts has been a subject of gossip in Wall street as well as uptown, where it is said that the elder money king is in much trouble.—N. Y. World.
