

Iver Jacobson

Iver Jacobson, of the firm of Jacobson and Serengard, attorneys and counselors-at-law, was born in Norway 1851. He went to Wisconsin in 1867, and located in Waupun. After remaining there two years, he went to La Crosse, Wis. where he received his education, and studied law with Judge Mills. of Arcadia, and was admitted to the Bar in the same district. He came to Dakota March 29, 1882, and located at Valley City, being admitted to the Bar in that city, Sept. 27, 1882. He began the practice of law with a former partner from Arcadia Wis., under the firm name of Mills and Jacobson. Mr. Jacobson was married Mar. 29, 1879 to Miss Julia M. Mills, the only daughter of Hon. Seth Mills of Valley City. They have had three children, only one of whom is living. Mr. Jacobson is a young man of good scholarship and experience in the law, and has a fine practice, besides dealing largely in loans and real estate.
