

Charles Northrop, Once Luverne, Dies In Fargo

Charles Newton Northrop, 81, former resident of Luverne, N. D., died Monday in a Fargo rest home where he had resided a year.

Born in Skaneateles, N. Y., Sept. 25, 1867, he came to Dakota Territory March 17, 1882, residing two years at Tower City and then moving to a farm between Luverne and Blabon.

Surviving are a brother, W. H. Northrop, 406 Eighth st S, and two sisters, Mrs. George L. Smith, Bellflower, Calif., and Mrs. T. A. Hasselquist, Jamestown, N. D. A brother preceded him in death.

Services will be at 10 Wednesday in the Lutheran church of Luverne with Masonic committal services in the Hope cemetery at 11:30. Ivers southside chapel is in charge.

Mr. Northrop was a member of Hope Masonic lodge and a life member of Order of Eastern Star.
