Alfred Olson Funeral Conducted Wednesday

Funeral services for Alfred Olson. 67, a resident of Mabel township for 40 years, who died at St. Luke's hospital in Fargo on Monday, July 4. were conducted from the home near Sutton last Wednesday. Interment was in the cemetery at Sutton.

Mr. Olson was taken seriously sick last October and upon entering the Fargo hospital it was found that he was suffering from cancer of the stomach, which disease resulted in

his death last week.

He was born in Dalsland, Sweden, on September 16, 1859, where he grew to manhood, migrating to this country at the age of 22, arriving in Fargo in 1881. A few years later he returned to Sweden but came back to North Dakota with his parents, settling in Mabel township, which has been his home ever since.

In 1890 he was married to Miss Emma Pederson, to which union nine children have been born, six of whom are still living. Besides his wife, two sons and four daughters, Mr. Olson leaves three brothers. They are: Gustaf Olson of Chicago; John Olson of Coleharbor and Christ Olson of

Sutton.
