Mrs. O. Overmoen Died Here Monday

Was Resident of Cooperstown Since 1904; Passes at Home Here

Mrs. Overmoen was born in Sondre Fron, Gudbrandalen, Norway, on January 2, 1867, her maiden name being Oline Fredrickson, and she was 69 years 3 months and 16 days old at the time of her death. She was united in marriage to Ole Hanson Overmoen in 1896, and they lived at Rigebu, Gudbransdalen, until 1903, when Mr. Overmoen came to this country. In 1904 he sent for the family and they have since lived at Cooperstown.

Besides the husband a son, Ole A. Overmoen of Raub, this state, and a daughter, Marit, of Cooperstown, survive. Two nephews and one brother in Norway, as well as several other relatives in this country and

Norway also survive.

Mrs. Overmoen was conscious until the very end and gave her daughter, Marit, who cared for her, every detail concerning the conduct of the funeral.
